Since then, Music Camp has become an integral part of the musical life of young South Australian players. Campers from one generation are seen to return either as proud parents of aspiring players, or, occasionally as tutors and conductors.

The value of State Music Camp is to place young players in an environment where they can musically succeed playing a challenging and interesting repertoire. Campers are supported by experienced tutors and conductors who have an empathy with young performers. The success of State Music Camp (formerly May Music Camp) is well demonstrated by the numbers of performers in our community who acknowledge the valuable part that Music Camp, State and National, has played in their musical life.

Concurrent with this Camp, over sixty young singers have been enjoying the pleasures of making music at the State Choral Camp. The two choirs were supported in their efforts by experienced conductors and accompanists and their concert last night proved the value of this initiative.
