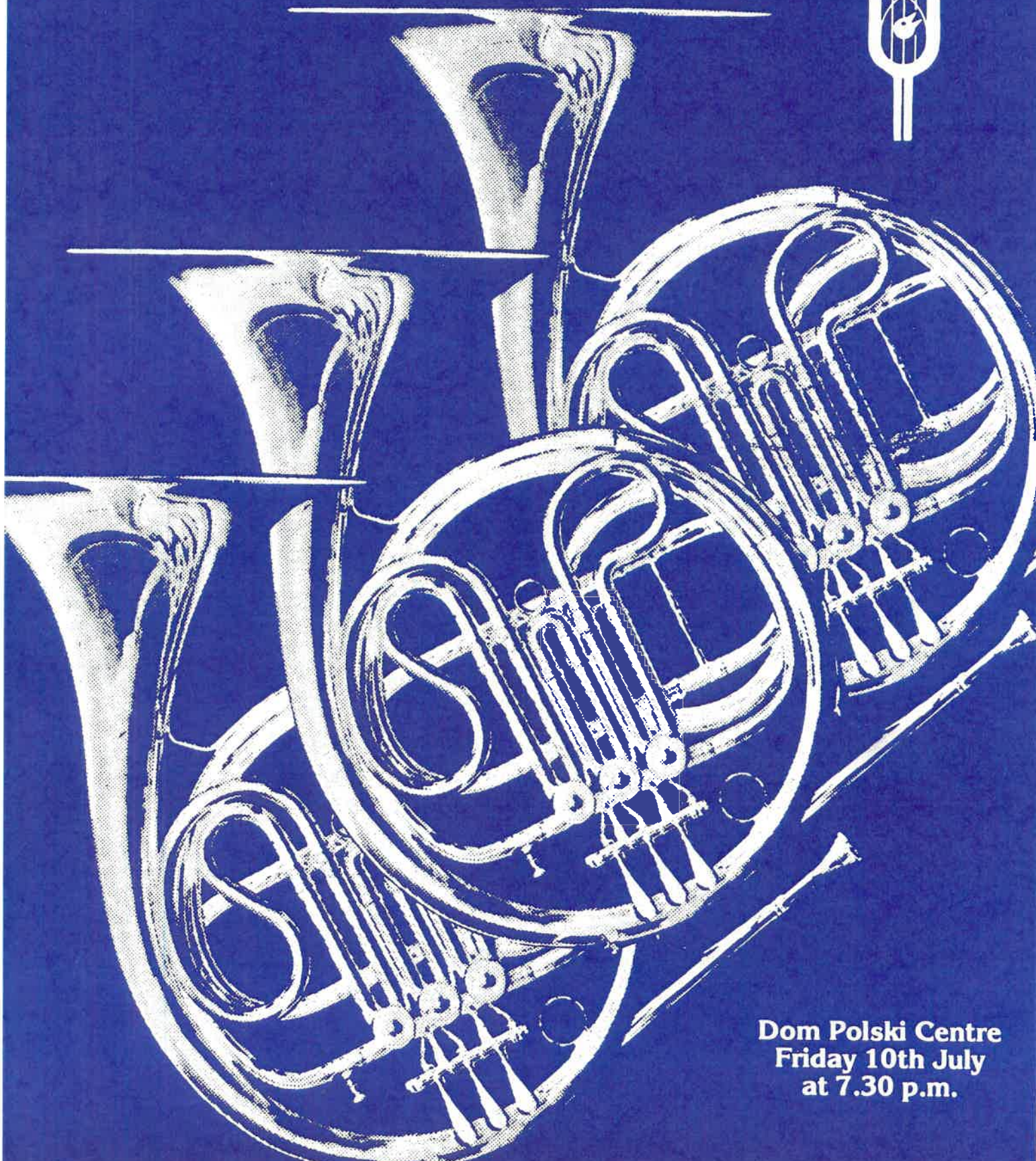

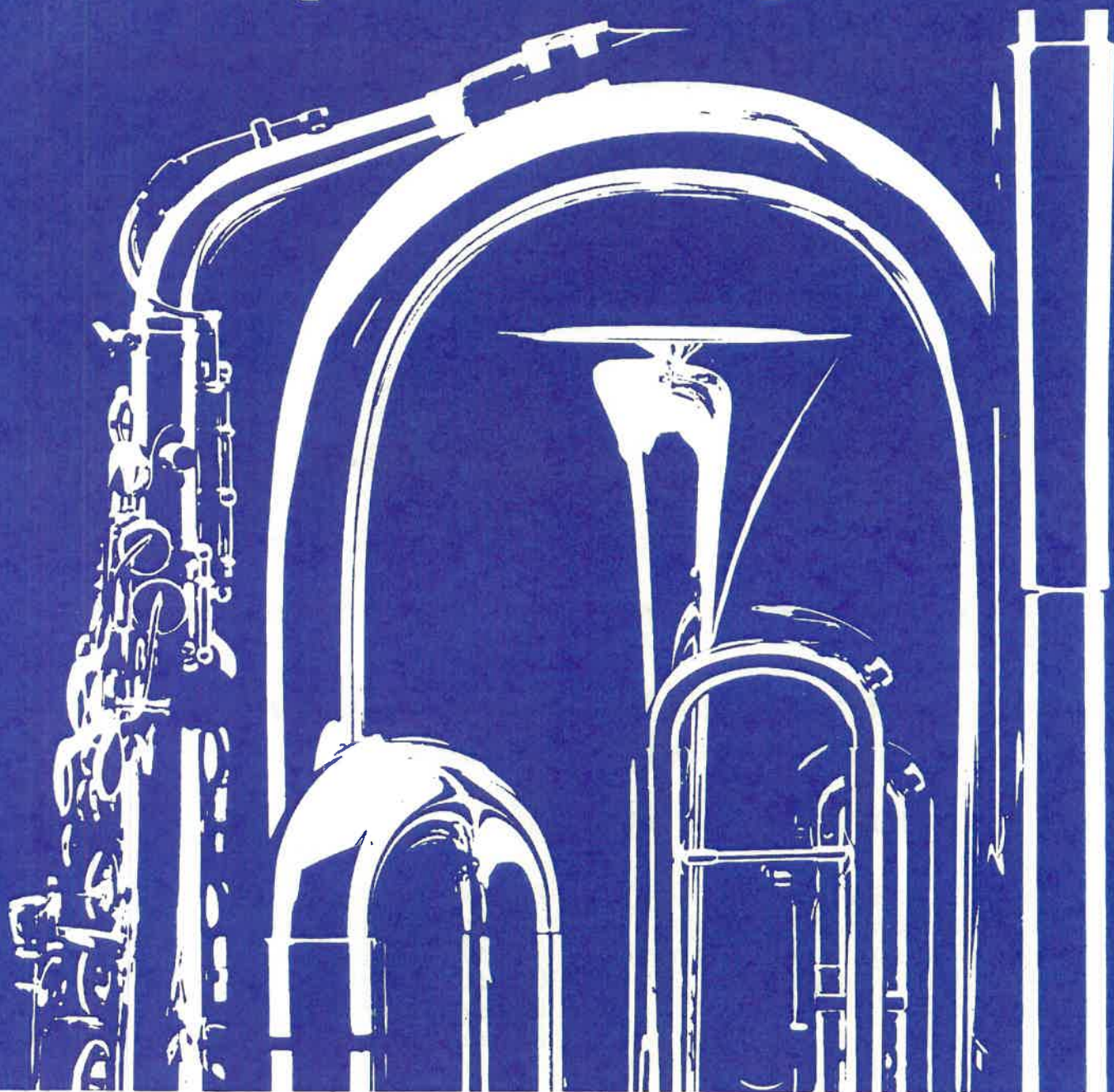

This year has seen a change of name and date because of the newly introduced four term school year. Some 250 young instrumentalists with ages ranging from 8 to 21 meet every year to form three orchestras and a concert band.

As an extension of this activity South Australian Music Camp Association formed the South Australian Youth Orchestra in 1978 to provide the opportunity for South Australia's foremost young musicians to work together at a high standard with a fine conductor.
