The South Australian Music Camp Association Inc was formed in 1962 to provide young instrumentalists with an opportunity to play in orchestras and has operated every year since then. Music Camp has for a long time become an integral part of the lives of young South Australian musicians. It is interesting to note that campers from an earlier generation often keep in touch with the movement, either as proud parents of keen young campers, or sometimes as tutors and conductors.

The value of State Music Camp is recognised by placing young players in a stimulating environment where they tackle and master challenging and enjoyable repertoire, and succeed in presenting an exciting final concert to parents and friends. What is achieved in one week is nothing short of miraculous. Campers are coached by experienced professional tutors and conductors who are chosen for their empathy with young performers. The success of State Music Camp (formerly May Music Camp) is well demonstrated by the numbers of well-established performers and teachers in our community who acknowledge the valuable part that Music Camp, State and National, has played in their own musical lives.

Concurrent with this Camp, nearly 50 young singers have been enjoying the pleasures of making music together at the State Choral Camp. The two choirs were coached by experienced conductors and accompanists and their highly successful concert last night was enjoyed by an enthusiastic audience.

RICHARD SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Richard Smith was an exceptional percussionist as both teacher and performer, who served Music Camp faithfully for many years until his death at the age of 80 in 1993. A scholarship dedicated to his memory was instituted by the State Music Committee in 1995. This year Jamie Adam has been nominated for the award in recognition of his contribution to this year's Camp. Jamie gave a brilliant audition and has demonstrated fine leadership qualities throughout the week's activities.
